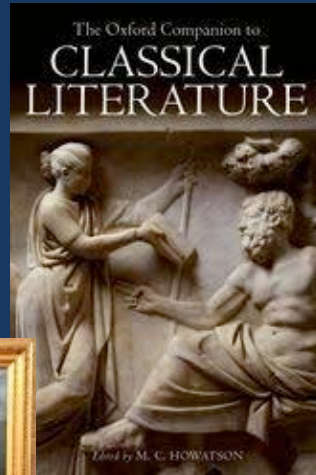

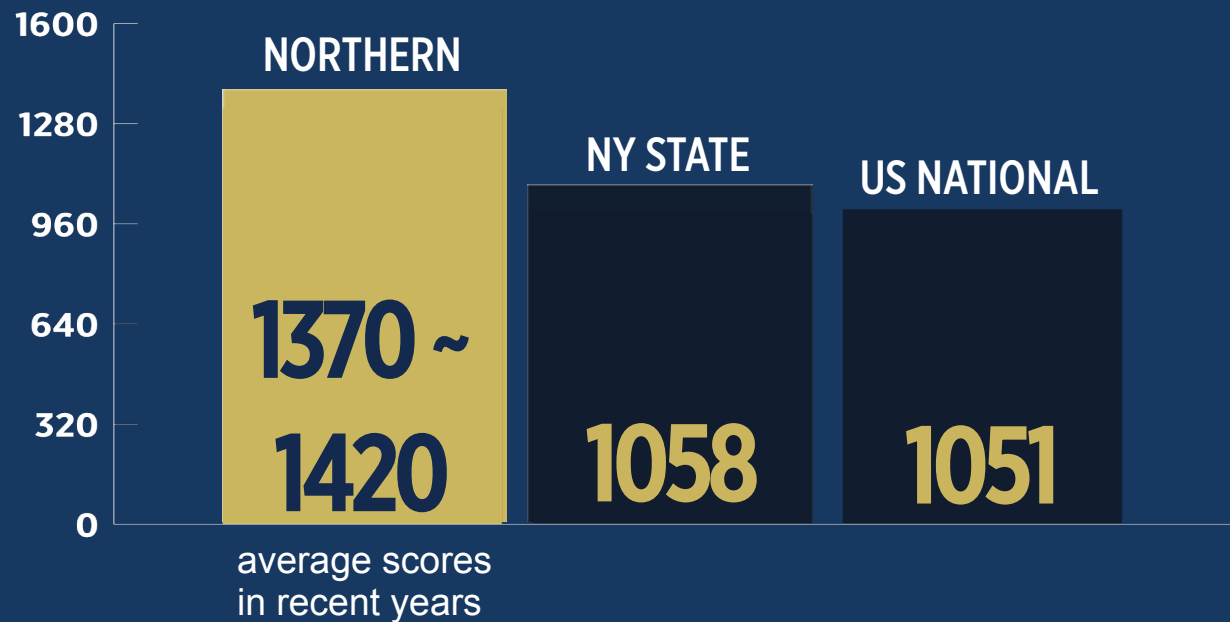

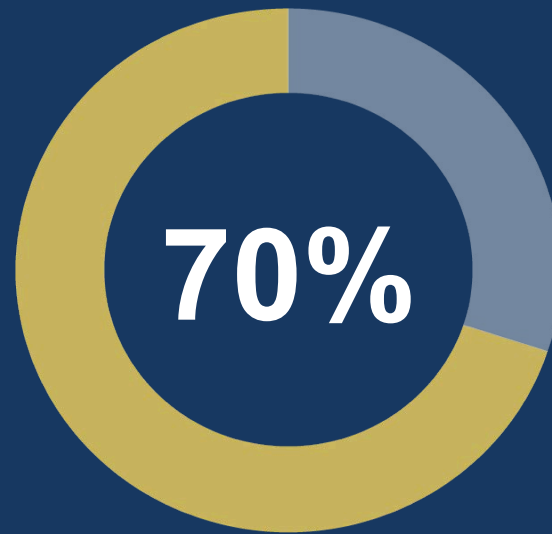
Advising
